When to use "will"	When to use "be going to"
<p>1. For future actions that may or may not happen. <i>Para acciones futuras que pueden suceder o no.</i> <i>Example: We will visit Disney World one day.</i></p> <p>2. For threats or warnings. <i>Por amenazas o advertencias.</i> <i>Example: Stop or I will shoot!</i></p> <p>3. In the moment decisions. <i>Decisiones en el momento.</i> <i>Example: I will have a cup of coffee, please.</i></p> <p>4. Offers. <i>Ofertas.</i> <i>Example: I will help you with your homework.</i></p> <p>5. Promises. <i>Promesas.</i> <i>Example: I will love you forever.</i></p> <p>6. Predictions. <i>Predicciones.</i> <i>Example: You will be very rich one day!</i></p>	<p>1. For future events that are decided. <i>Para futuros eventos que se decidan.</i> <i>Example: I am going to visit my parents next week.</i></p> <p>2. For evident future events. Things we can see. <i>Para eventos futuros evidentes.</i> <i>Cosas que podemos ver.</i> <i>Example: Look! She is going to fall!</i></p>
